- Students must earn a grade of C or higher in all required ECE courses. These courses are noted with a "*" symbol.
- EE students must complete 8 Technical Electives. A minimum of 5 Technical Electives must be ECE courses. Remaining Technical Electives can be upper-division courses related to your major (e.g., math, physics, engineering, technology) or ECE courses.
- Students must declare advanced standing status between their sophomore and junior semesters in order to take 300/400 level engineering courses. Students must maintain a minimum of 2.5 GPA within their engineering coursework.
