**M.S. Thesis Option**

- 24 units of graduate coursework (5xx or 6xx) subject to the following limitations:
- A maximum of 6 units of non-ECE coursework. All non-ECE coursework must be pre-approved by the Graduate Studies Committee prior to registration.
- Paper: Must submit at least one paper to a refereed conference or journal, with an ECE faculty member as a co-author.
- Thesis 6 units of thesis (ECE 910).
- Final defense: Must pass an oral defense of the thesis.

**M.S. Non-Thesis Option**

- 30 units of graduate coursework (5xx or 6xx) subject to the following limitations:
- A maximum of 9 units of non-ECE coursework. All non-ECE coursework must be pre-approved by the Graduate Studies Committee prior to registration. Pre-Approved Non-ECE is normally Math, Physics, Any Other Engineering Major, CSC
